Seeds per Cell/Plug Time: 288/128 cells for 72 to 21 trays. Sow 5-7 Seeds p. Cell, add 3-4 weeks plug time & reduce finish time by 3 weeks.

Plugs per pot: 1-gallon/30 cm pot. For 2-3 gallons/60-90 cm, add 3 weeks finish time.
More Seeds p. Cell/Plugs p. Pot will result in faster finish.



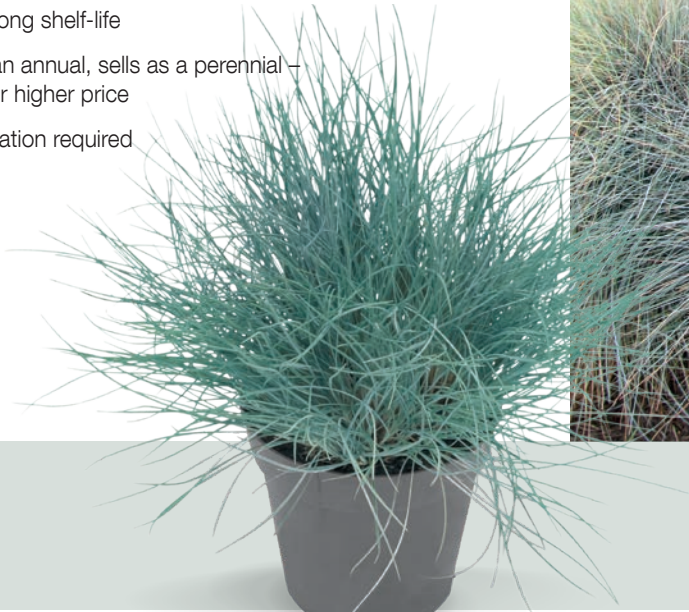

- Tuft-forming habit, wintergreen
- No vernalization required

- Finely textured ornamental grass – Versatile uses in mixed containers or in the garden

- No vernalization required

Pony Tails

- Shining silvery panicles with long awns, soft fine, hair-like leaves
- Wintergreen
- Attractive tuft-forming plant
- Excellent for group plantings
- Eye-catcher as standalone plant
- Ideal for containers and cut production
- No vernalization required

Fluffy

- Greenish-white spikelets developing to a more purple coloring with age
- Fresh green, straight foliage with feathery inflorescence
- Excellent for group and mass plantings
- Eye-catcher as stand-alone plant
- No vernalization required

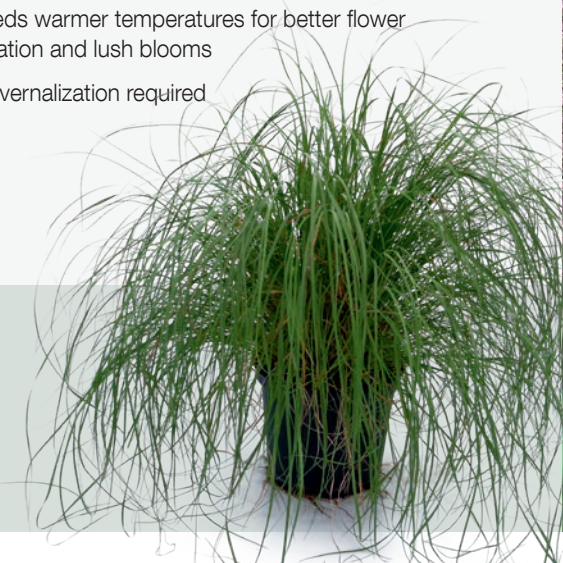

Rosy

- Densely tufted, clump-forming
- Glossy green foliage
- Reddish-pink flowers float above the foliage
- Smaller in stature and softer blooms than Ruby
- More cold hardy than Ruby
- Heat and drought tolerant
- Needs warmer temperatures for better flower initiation and lush blooms
- No vernalization required

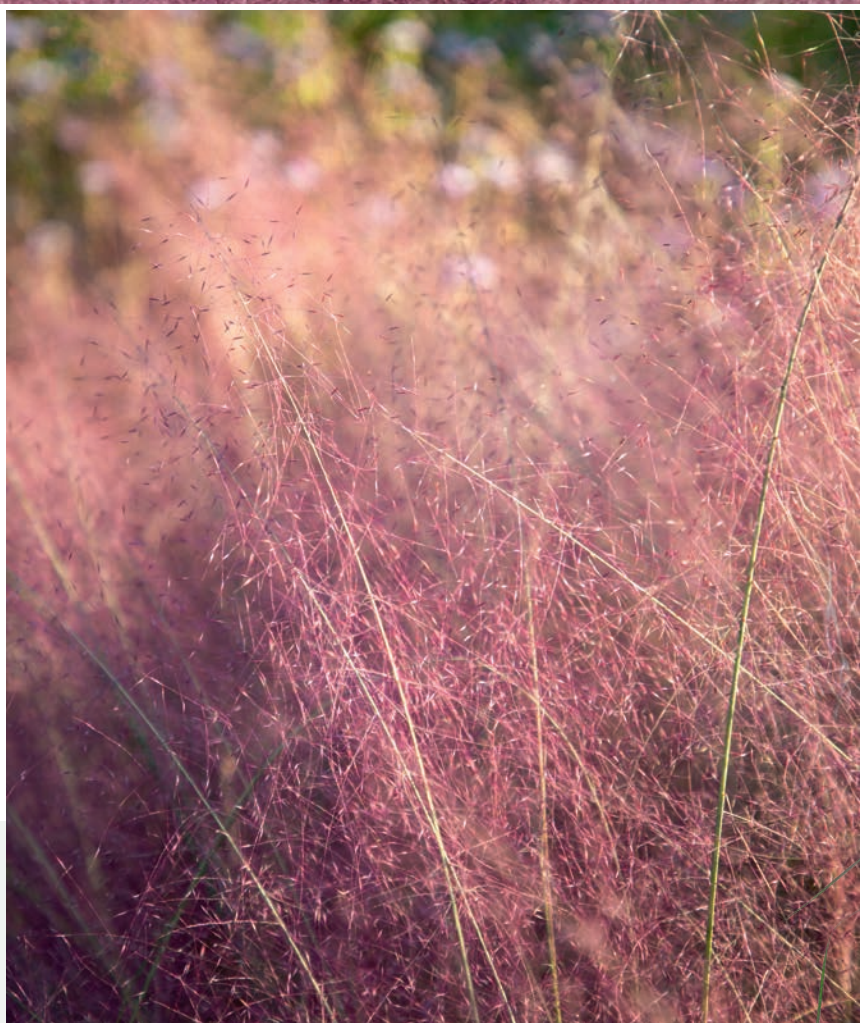

Ruby

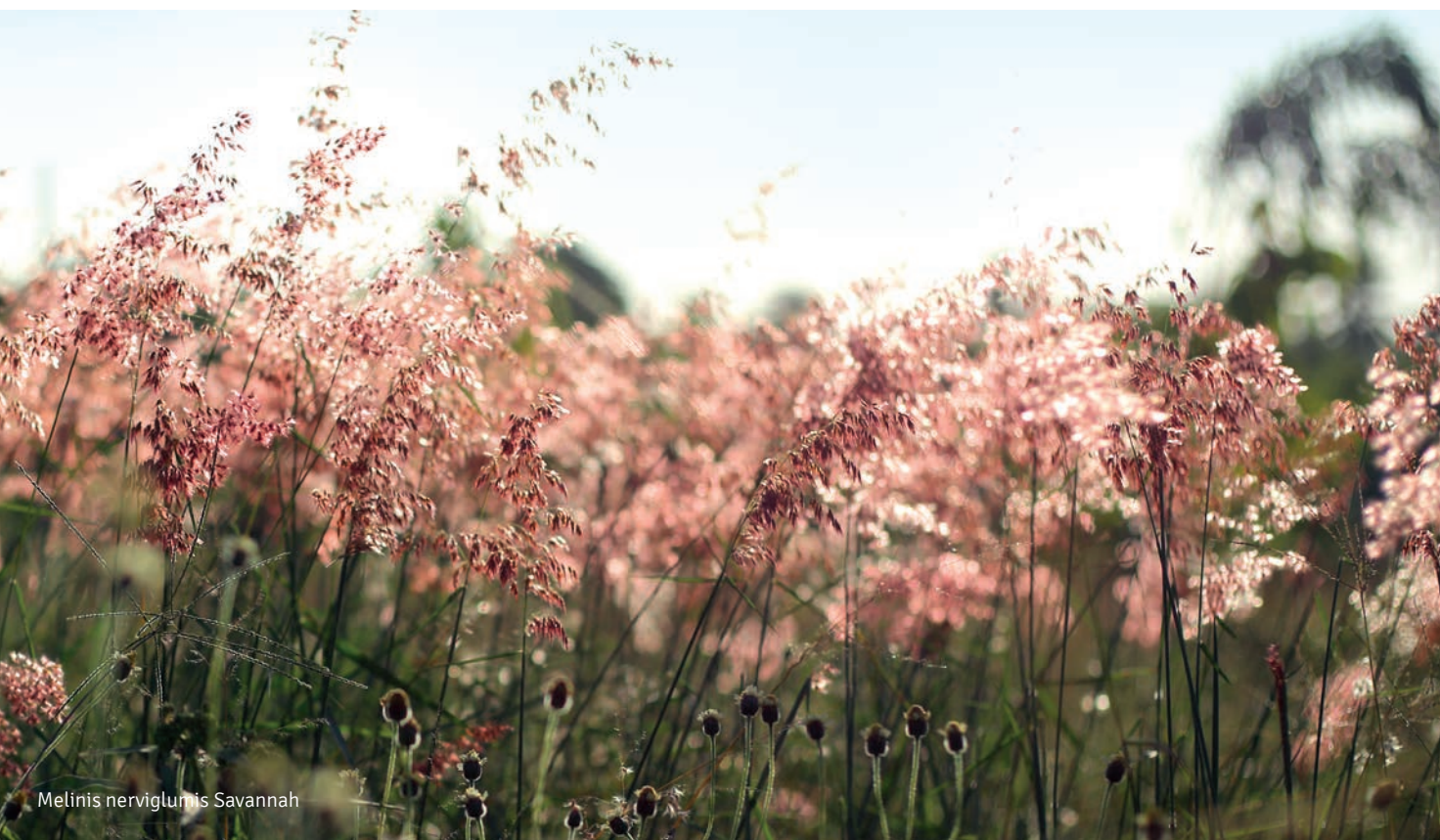
- Amazing pink colored blooms

- Highly preferred by landscape architects
- Heat and drought tolerant
- Attracts butterflies
- No vernalization required
